

Career Navigator/Case Manager

The Housing Authority of the City of Camden (HACC) is seeking a **Full-Time Career Navigator/Case Manager** who can work to connect youth ages 16-18 and adults to education and/or stable employment and supportive services under the Choice Neighborhood Implementation grant funded program.

We are searching for a methodical and strategic Career Navigator/Case Manager to work with participants to assess personal strengths, navigate educational and workforce options, and develop individualized plans to achieve educational goals, develop work readiness competencies, find work-based experiences, and secure and maintain gainful employment. The Career Navigator/Case Manager is also responsible for building strategic relationships, conducting a variety of outreach activities, and recruiting and retaining public housing residents for the Housing Authority of the City of Camden's, Choice Neighborhood Implementation program.

The ideal candidate for this role should have superior organizational skills, great leadership, mentoring and motivating skills.

Salary range: \$50,000 - \$54,999 per year.
