

**PUBLIC NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD
HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF CAMDEN (HACC)
PROPOSED DESIGNATED HOUSING PLAN**

The Housing Authority of the City of Camden (HACC) has prepared a Designated Housing Plan (DHP) for submission to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The proposed DHP would designate the following public housing developments for occupancy by elderly families (households in which the head of households, spouse, or co-head are age 62 or older):

- Kennedy Tower`
- Baldwin's Run Senior Tower

The purpose of the designation is to better serve the housing needs of elderly residents while ensuring that sufficient housing opportunities remain available for non-elderly families, including families with disabilities.

The proposed Designated Housing Plan will be available for public review beginning **August 1, 2026** through **September 15, 2026** at HACC's administrative offices located at 2021 Watson Street, Camden, NJ 08105, during normal business hours.
